<b>Personal:</b> Weather appropriate clothing, Appropriate walking shoes, Lunch, Helmet, Harness.	
<b>Group:</b> Weather appropriate clothing, Walking Shoes, Lunch, Drink, Helmet, Harness, Ropes, Rack.	
<b>Instructor:</b> Phone, first aid kit, group shelter, torch, hot drink, emergency food, whistle, knife, spare emergency clothing for group (cannot supply for full group, must have a some basics, EG: hats, gloves, etc..)	
<b>For the Mountain Activities risk assessment please refer to the Climbing Risk Assessment and Walks Risk Assessment, as Mountain Activities is a combination of these two activities.</b>
